Fieldwork Dates: 22/05/20 - 31/05/20

Data Collection Method: The survey was conducted via online panel.

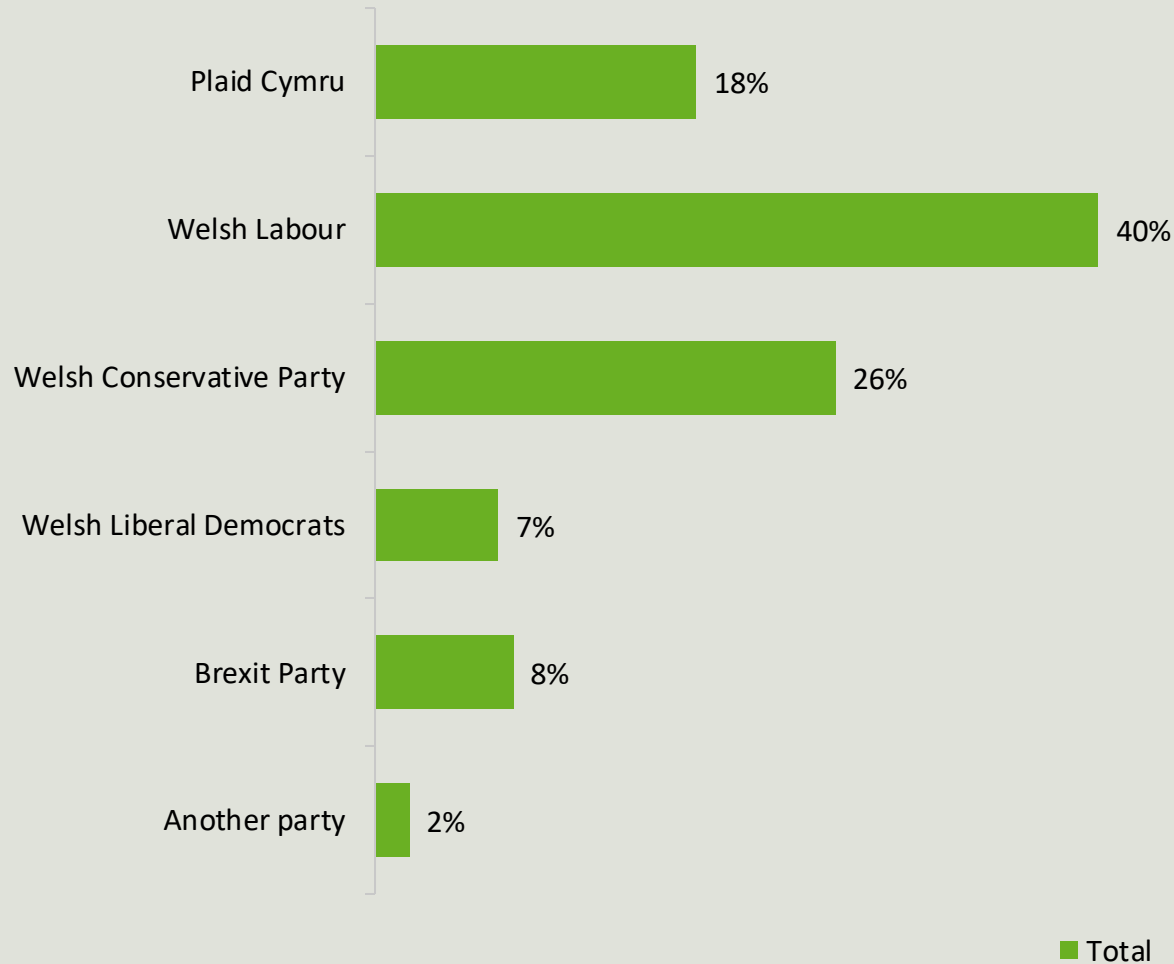
Data were weighted to the profile of all people in Wales aged 16+. Data were weighted by age, sex, Welsh region, 2019 general election vote, 2017 general election vote, 2016 EU referendum vote and 2016 Welsh Assembly constituency vote. Targets for the weighted data were derived from Office for National Statistics Census Data and the results of the 2019 and 2017 UK general elections, the 2016 EU referendum and the 2016 Welsh Assembly election.

Population Sampled: All residents aged 16+ living in Wales

Sample Size: 1,051

Q1. In the next Senedd election you will be given two votes. Your first vote will be for a single person to represent your constituency in the Welsh Parliament.

If the election were tomorrow, which party would you be most likely to vote for with your first, constituency vote?



Q2. Your second vote will be a party list vote to elect representatives from your region of Wales by a form of proportional representation.
